The operative program for cardiac surgery

- Coronary artery graft surgery (CABG).
- Off-pump coronary artery bypass surgery (Off-pump CABG)
- Repair or replacement Surgery of aortic valve via sternotomy
- Repair or replacement Surgery of aortic valve via partial upper sternotomy
- Mitral valve repair or mitral valve replacement
- Mitral valve repair or mitral valve replacement via partial upper sternotomy
- Main artery of the aorta Surgery.
- Combination of coronary surgery and valve surgery.
- Severe heart failure Surgery.
- Heart tumors removal.

The operative program for thoracic surgery

- I- Lung Cancer Surgery through Video-Assisted Thoracoscopic Surgery (VATS):**
- Non-anatomical sublobar resection (wedge)
 - Anatomical segment resection
 - Lobectomy with radical lymphadenectomy (Biportal-VATS)
 - Bullectomies through Video-Assisted Thoracoscopic Surgery (VATS)
 - Video-Assisted Thoracoscopic Decortication/ Pleurectomy
 - Interstitial Lung Disease Biopsie via (VATS)

II- Open lung cancer surgery via an anterolateral approach:

- Non-anatomical resection via anterolateral thoracotomy (ALT)
- Anatomical segment resection (ALT)
- Lobectomy (ALT)
- Pulmonary sleeve resection (PSR) via anterolateral thoracotomy (ALT)
- Pleurectomy via anterolateral thorakotomy
- Surgical treatment of the bronchopleural fistula (caused by lung cancer surgery, pneumonectomy (removal of lung), chemotherapy, radiation, or an infection)
- Surgical treatment of Non resolving Pneumonia (NRP)

III- Resection of the thoracic wall tumors with partial rib resection and subsequent chest wall reconstruction using a bovine pericardial patch

IV- Metastasis surgery

V- Open thorax window

VI- Pectoralis muscle flap in sternal wound infection

Latissimus flap surgery in Deep sternal wound infection

VII- Mediastinoscopy

VIII- Diaphragmatic plication for eventration or paralysis

IX- Pediatric Thoracic Surgery (Children)

X- Tracheotomy, Port implantation, Permanent drainage - PleurX catheter in the palliative therapy concept, Chest drain
